- **Choose Life Vehicle Tag:** Consider a Choose Life Tag when you renew your tags. This benefits your local pregnancy centers and shares the message.

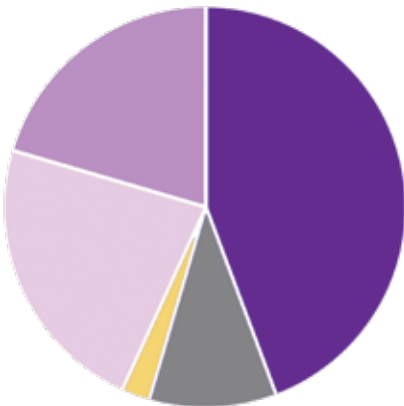


Host a Baby Bottle Campaign
